<b>Planning / Implementation</b>				
1.1	A suitable teaching opportunity employing laptops has been identified.			
1.2	Differentiation, student learning styles and/or gender issues relating to laptop use have been considered.			
1.3	Enhanced teacher communication through laptop use is evident e.g. setting tasks by email or publishing resources on a teacher web site.			
1.4	Laptop teaching / learning activity is meaningfully integrated with other opportunities within the teaching scheme.			
<b>Teaching Content / Method</b>				
2.1	Internet / Intranet content is appropriately matched to the task and students.			
2.2	Online stimulus material, CD or DVD is used to promote higher order thinking e.g. use of Web Quest.			
2.3	The teacher demonstrates a willingness & ability to share ICT skills with students and visa versa.			
2.4	Collaborative, group or teamwork is evident or alternatively self-paced work promoted with laptops is evident.			
2.5	Peripheral devices are used to improve teaching and learning e.g. scanners or digital cameras.			
<b>Classroom / Learning Management</b>				
3.1	Health and Safety matters are considered e.g. positioning of laptop for user comfort.			
3.2	Appropriate laptop care is promoted e.g. correct use of carry bags.			
3.3	Students remain focussed on learning and are not distracted by the use of laptops e.g. playing games or using unauthorised chat.			
3.4	Demonstrations using software and / or hardware are clear and aid pupil's understanding e.g. terminology is explained.
